We have actually (sort of) received an invitation to the Bournemouth Wheels 3 day event this year which takes place on the 29th, 30th, and 31st May, but I don't think any of you will like it much. Large Clubs that can "**Guarantee**" a large and "**Interesting**" display of cars for at least 2 of the 3 days are *invited to apply* for a spot half way along the Undercliffe. All the cars must arrive together between 8 and 10am and must remain in place until the public have dispersed (about 7pm).

Smaller Clubs can *apply* to be towards the Boscombe Pier end and the same conditions apply with the exception that they **may** be allowed to start to leave under controlled conditions after approximately 4.00pm.

There will be a limited number of spaces for Individuals, but preference will be given to "*older*" vehicles in "*outstanding condition*" of "*particular interest*"- This will be on a "first come first served" basis at Boscombe pier. You still have to apply in advance by email to obtain a pass.
